Weekly Pride Check-Up from Bro. Dean:

- 4. <u>Draw Attention to Myself</u> (Proverbs 27:2)
- "I like to be the *center of attention* and will say or do things to draw attention to myself."
- 5. Like to Talk About Myself
- "I like to talk, especially about myself or persons or things I am involved with. I want people to know what I am doing or thinking. I would rather speak than listen. I have a hard time being succinct."
- 6. <u>Deceitful and Pretentious</u> (Psalm 24:3-4, 26:2-4; Jeremiah 48:10; Proverbs 26:20-26)
- "I tend to be *deceptive* about myself. I find myself lying to preserve my reputation. I find myself hiding the truth about myself, especially about sins, weaknesses, etc. I don't want people to know who I really am."

Read with the following suggestions in mind.

- 1. Ask God to illuminate your mind so you can discover any characteristics of pride that may exist in your life.
- 2. Ask God to convict you on specific points of pride.
- 3. Confess your pride to God and ask for His forgiveness (1 John 1:9).
- 4. Ask God to give you a holy hatred for pride & its fruit in your life. Be continually on the alert. Don't allow pride to grow in your heart.


