Weekly Pride Check-Up from Bro. Dean:

10. Anxious (Psalm 4:8; Philippians 4:6-7; 1 Peter 5:6-7)

"I am often *anxious* about my life and the future. I tend not to trust God and rarely experience His abiding and transcendent peace in my soul. I have a hard time sleeping at night because of fearful thoughts and burdens I carry."

8. <u>Self-Focused</u> (Exodus 4:11; Job 10:8-11; Psalm 139:13-16; Isaiah 53:2; Jeremiah 1:5)

"I am *overly self-conscious*. I tend to replay in my mind how I did, what I said, and how I came across to others. I am very concerned about my appearance and what people think of me. I think about these things constantly."

9. Fear Man (Proverbs 29:25)

" I fear man more than God. I am afraid of others and make decisions about I will say or do based upon this fear. I am afraid to take a stand for things that are right. I am concerned with how people will react to me or perceive my actions or words. I don't often think about God's opinion and rarely think there could be consequences for disobeying Him. I mainly seek the approval of man and not of God."

Read with the following suggestions in mind.

- 1. Ask God to illuminate your mind so you can discover any pride that may exist in your life.
- 2. Ask God to convict you on specific points of pride.
- Confess your pride to God and ask for His 3. forgiveness (1 John 1:9).
- Ask God to give you a holy hatred for pride & its fruit. Be continually on the alert.
